Regular Commission Meeting

Graceville City Commission met in regular session Tuesday January 11, 2022, at 6:00 pm with the following commissioners present Curtis Pinkard, Arthur Obar, Walter Olds, John McClendon, and Marshall Davis.

Also present were Michelle Watkins, Misty Smith, Frank Bondurant (all by zoom), Llyod Laycox, David Park, David Hughes, Sharon Lemons, Claude Pratt, Tom Lawson, Geraldine De Felix, Bill Morrow, and Courtney Giles.

Olds made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Pinkard seconded. All voted in favor.

Obar read resolution 22-0111 regarding 6th Ave Closure. Obar opened floor for discussion. Sharon Lemons questioned where the street was located, Watkins stated that is not by Alabama St. Olds made a motion to approve closure the street and Davis seconded. All voted in favor.

Obar read resolution 22-0112. The resolution read the following, A resolution calling for the general election of city commissioners of the city of Graceville, FL; providing for election criteria; providing for candidate qualifications for group 2 and 4; providing for inspections and clerk of elections; and providing for legal notice. Obar stated group 2 and 4 was up for re-election, election was April 12, 2022, and qualifying dates were from noon on February 7 until Feb 11th at noon. Olds made a motion to approve the resolution calling for election and Pinkard seconded. All voted in favor.

Obar read resolution 22-0113. The resolution read the following, A resolution authorizing the submission of an application for the municipal small county outreach program (M-SCOP) to the Florida Department of Transportation. McClendon made a motion to approve the submission of application and Pinkard seconded. All in favor.

Obar announced the appointment of committee for RFP for construction and CEI Mill Creek. The following were appointed to the committee, Marshall Davis, Michelle Watkins, Charlie Martin, Eddie King, and Misty Smith. Pinkard made a motion to approve the appointment of committee and McClendon seconded. All voted in favor.

Watkins gave an update on ditch cleanup.

Obar also stated house numbers were still available.

Courtney Giles addressed commission stated the Woman's Club was not wanting to do The Graceville Pageant this year and the Pee Wee Football wanted to take over the pageant this




year. The proceeds would go the Graceville Pee Wee Football. Olds voted in favor and Pinkard seconded. All voted in favor.
